PURPOSE

The City of Walker wants to work together with your group to Adopt-A-Road. This program is similar to the Michigan Department of Transportation's Adopt-A-Highway Program. The purpose of Adopt-A-Road is to involve Walker citizens in keeping their local roads clean, safe, and visually appealing. Your group may adopt as little as one (1) mile and as many as four (4) miles.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Any group of ten (10) or more people can Adopt-A-Road. We encourage service organizations, schools, scout troops, senior groups and businesses to get involved in the program. Group participants must be at least sixteen (16) years of age or older unless otherwise approved by the City of Walker. We require that groups participating in the Adopt-A-Road program commit to a minimum of three (3) cleanups per calendar year.

SAFETY

All participants are required to wear high visibility vests or bright clothing while cleaning the roadside. Safety vests and trash bags may be picked up at the Department of Public Works office Monday through Friday between 7:30am and 3:30pm. Any lost, stolen or damaged vests must be replaced by the adoptive group at their own expense. Vests are to be returned to the City of Walker as soon as possible to ensure they are available for other adoptive groups' usage. All participants of the Adopt-A-Road Program must conduct a safety meeting once a year prior to their first pickup. The City of Walker Department of Public Works will provide safety rules and guidelines to ensure that your group has a safe and worthwhile experience.

RESPONSIBILITY

It is the responsibility of your group and/or group leader to make sure that cleanups are recorded with the City of Walker towards the minimum requirement. Please be sure to document all cleanups on the recording log on the second page of the safety rules packet. Replacement packets are available upon request.

RECOGNITION

All groups that Adopt-A-Road will have a sign displayed on their portion of the road recognizing their involvement in the program at the City's expense. Each group will receive a certificate to display in their lobby or business.
